Valencia, March 29-30

TRAVEL, LODGING AND LOGISTICS

The conference venue will be the **Parc Científic de la Universitat de Valencia**, located in the Burjassot-Paterna Science Campus of the University.

Valencia is well communicated to the rest of the main capitals in Spain and Europe. The airport is located at approximately 10 minutes by car to the conference venue, and approximately 20 minutes from the recommended hotel. There are several daily flights to Madrid and Barcelona, many to other Spanish cities, as well as to Europe's main hubs.

Valencia is connected via high-speed train (AVE) to Madrid, that can be reached in less than two hours. It is also connected via a fast train (EuroMed) to Barcelona. In case you travel by car, the main highways link Valencia to Madrid (A3), Barcelona and Alicante (AP7) and Zaragoza (A23).

The organisers have selected **the NH Valencia Center** as the recommended hotel for people attending the conference. We have arranged for a special fee to be charged to you, but please remember to mention you are attending the conference organised by the “Observatori Astronòmic de la Universitat de Valencia” (ref. **146721851**) when making your reservation. Notice that we have reserved and secured this special fee, but there is no room block reservation, so please organise your lodging as soon as possible. Please contact us if there were any problems so that we can find other options.

In order to reach the Observatori from the hotel and back, we recommend you to either use the public bus (line 63 stopping at Av. Pio XII) or take a taxi.
